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General Information

This document describes the Bridge eCQM v1.0 Real Word Test Plan for the year 2025 The 21st Century Cures Act Final rule mandates that health IT developers of certified health IT test the real-world use of Health IT for interoperability, as defined by the 2015 Edition Certification Criteria. The functionality and use cases included in this testing effort include all certification criteria under 45 C.F.R. §170.315 (c)(1-3) to which Bridge eCQM v1.0 is certified. This test plan evaluates the real-world usage of the certified criteria, while limiting provider and office workflow disruption.
